






Hyperobject Painting Series, 2021 (ongoing) Acrylic

These are paintings based on the writings of Timothy Morton and Graham Harmon. Their respective philosophies inspire me greatly and continue to present themselves in my work.



Everybody Dreams:

A Statistical Analysis of the Dreams of Men and Women

On average, men tended to dream of unfamiliar characters at a higher rate than women.

When we look at the amount of participants that dreamt of a familiar versus unfamiliar place, we see that women dreamt of <u>familiar settings</u> 38% more in proportion to men.





Other factors examined included the presence of physical agression and victimization in dreams. Men dreamt of **physical agression 33% more** than women as opposed to **victimization**, which was present in women's dreams **14% more** than men.

Though this research is interesting to look at, it is impossible to draw conclusions on this information given varying sources of error such as envrionmental issues affecting recollection of dreams, and the difficulty of extracting data based on the memories of each of the participants., if they happened to remember their dream that day.







Magazine cover inspired by pulp fiction magazines of the 50s.







A business card and folder design made for a recent client. The logo was designed by me as well.


