

- The words are found through the letters on the screen, users need to drag their finger around on them to spell out the word.






Lumosity

- Founded by Kunal Sarkar, Michael Scanlon, and David Drescher in 2005, officially launching in 2007 as a brain training program meant to enhance flexibility, memory, and problem solving skills.
- One of their games, Tidal Treasures, has users click on objects that are 'washed away' by the tide and to not click on the same item twice, even as more items appear on screen.
- Speed Pack is a game that has users visualize in suitcases how to pack a camera without overlapping with other objects.
- The games are mostly timed with vector based graphics and catchy sounds that are meant to help the user focus.





Game Level 4


- Rooftop Orchard:


