

DESIGN BRIEF:



DESIGN BRIEF:






Dogs need at least two hours with their owner everyday. To prolong the time with dogs, this space effectively combine pet-owners' exercise time with dog-walking time.









Function diagram



The partition door effectively isolates noises from the other functional zone


