Testing placement and different weights of wrapped cotton roving and cording.




Hand basting

Pleat folds stay exposed on the shoulder on the garment.




One large peice with drawstring placement sewn on the outside. Then sewn and pulled together.



Muslin sample of the drawstring tunic.













