About Me



Test 1 Putting paper towel into the water, then freeze them together.

The above part of my model is a paper towel with water, and I put it into the fridge to keep it into a certain shape. And also formulating the process of how does a cloud form. The result of the shape is not predictable. The bottom part is a representation of the audience. Each one is looking at those "clouds" at a different angle, which means they all have different views. At first, I was thinking of using a mirror or some reflective texture to make the "audience" part, but later on, I realized that the reflections are too clear for us when we are trying to express something, it should be much vaguer. Then, I decide to use those translucent materials. Different shapes are representing the different backgrounds of people, which means they see things differently.

Preparation What do you need: A Boosk (Book Mask), A Speaker&hearer, A Book you want to feel, A place where things can be placed (Table), A thing you can sit on (Chair).

When we talk about the library, most people believe that it's a tool for us to find information. But I think the meaning of the library is far beyond a tool. Otherwise, the internet is much easier and more convenient to use. I think a library is a place for not only local people but also tourist to feel the history and cultural background for the city. Therefore, I want the armature focuses on helping people feel the things behind books. Rather than finding information in the library, reading text on the book, let people notice the things besides words. And what left? The design of books, feeling of physical paper, how does page connected, the smells when the age of books getting old. Speak to it, and hear the echo from the last person. Books are never made out of words, there are so many things we cannot notice in our daily life. So close your eyes, and "read" it.


Steps



Step 1

Open one eye, do not focus on words, feel the layouts, book cover,

how does paper connect, how many pages does it have and etc.





Step 2

Close two eyes, use your hand or other parts of your body to feel the book, how does the texture of paper feel, how hard the book cover is, is the book new or old, does the edge of paper still hurt your hand, etc.





Step 4 Speak and Hear 1) Do step 4 without reading the book: Ask the book a question, it could be the content of the book or other things you want to know about. And hear the answer from the book.

2) Do step 4 after finishing the book: Give it a comment, do you like it or not, or even curse it if you do not appreciate reading it. And hear the reply from the book or try to capture the last person did step 4 if you are in the library.






Artificial Water Cooling
