
Site relationship with surrounding areas

Experiential Space Castle Clinton, The Battery, NY

Scientific evidence has shown that sea levels are rising. Our reaction to this has been largely predicated on devising engineering solutions that keep water out. This project aims to re-frame our relationship with water to ask, how can we experience and, eventually, live with water as a dynamic and fluctuating condition? Asubterranean void at the edge of the coastal city of Manhattan provides territory for exploring this condition **by** deploying slope and surface to register the tidal shifts of the Atlantic Ocean.











Initial Concept Material Palette






Store Front Elevation



DWELLING 1061, 1063, 1065 Fulton St, Brooklyn

Loos designed a raised seating space with a theater box and a **private space** contrasts with the public space of the house. The theater box draws attention to itself and the occupant of the box looks out and at the same time, the one looking at it sees the most intimate space, **objectifying** the user in the box. During design development, got inspired by play "Hamlet" and a philosophical idea comes in. Hamlet shows a stoical idea towards the end of the play, and with my interpretation, it was brought in to the space.


LAYERING MOVEMBLE STUDY


The other parts of fennel are mostly used as herb or spice and it is a good match with seafoods. Fennel is loved by people due to its medicinal sides with great refreshing scent.













Floor Plan
